## alogis-aktives-EDI-Monitoring

The tool for automated checks of inbound messages



### alogis-aktives-EDI-Monitoring – warns employees about errors in inbound messages via email or text message

EDI is actively used for implementing closely linked and timecritical processes between business partners. And despite this, error messages continue to hamper the process and manual intervention is required, tying up your resources for proactive support tasks.

#### What does alogis-aktives-EDI-Monitoring offer?

**alogis-aktives-EDI-Monitoring** provides employees responsible with targeted information (e.g. by email or text message) when a fault occurs and thus reduces the support effort. With active EDI Monitoring, alogis provides a tool for automating checks of inbound messages under SAP®R/3<sup>®</sup>.

**alogis-aktives-EDI-Monitoring** periodically checks all inbound messages against the rules defined by the user and stored in the system. If a regulation applies to a message, this message is added into the worklist. Determined by the settings in the system, an instant message is then sent to the employee concerned, or it waits until a specified number of errors has occurred before then sending a collective message.

Depending on business data, the recipient can also be selected using customer-specific functional components. This data can be determined from the IDoc itself or the SAP data (master or document data) belonging to the message.

The number of IDocs involved is listed in the message by message type and IDoc status. With this information, you can initiate specific error processing.

alogis-aktives-EDI-Monitoring can also retrieve the SAP® Workflow. This means IDocs can be processed directly from the message.

In addition to email, other communication types (e.g. text message) can also be integrated depending on the technical equipment.



#### Features

- Monitor EDI messages with active notification function
